Epsilon Epsilon Omega Chapter is an alumnae chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority serving Champaign, Urbana, Danville, Savoy and Rantoul since 1949. Epsilon Epsilon Omega Chapter has awarded scholarships to African-American college bound women for more than 30 years.

Applicant Academic Scholarship Criteria

- Full-time high school senior
- Reside in Champaign/Vermilion county
- Demonstrate community service involvement
- African-American female
- Minimum GPA of 2.5/4.0 or C+
- Identify academic recognition

Criteria for Selection

Applications must contain all of the items below. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. Completed application form including a typed Personal Goal Statement (See Section D)
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation. Letters must include the recommender's contact information.
3. Official unopened transcript(s) from all high schools that you have attended. **MUST** include cumulative GPA .

- Complete the official Academic Scholarship Application Form (attached). **Applications must be signed by a parent/guardian.**
