Applicant Academic Scholarship Criteria

Full-time high school senior	African-American female
Reside in Champaign/Vermilion county	Minimum GPA of 2.5/4.0 or 3.1/5.0 equivalent scale
Demonstrate community service involvement	Identify academic recognition

Criteria for Selection

Applications must contain ***all*** of the items below. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. The completed application form including a typed essay (See Section D).
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation, including the contact information for each person who wrote a letter of recommendation.
3. Official unopened transcript(s) from all high schools that you have attended. **Your transcript(s) must** include a cumulative grade point average/GPA.

- Complete the official Academic Scholarship Application Form (attached). Applications must **be signed by a parent/legal guardian, unless the applicant is 18 years of age or emancipated.**
